## Caro Community Schools 1:1 Device Student Pledge

I will take good care of my Device and know that I will be issued the same Device each year.

I will never leave my Device unattended in an unsecured or unsupervised location.

I will never leave my Device in a location where it may be stepped on.

I will never loan out my Device to other individuals.

I will know where my Device is at all times.

I will charge my Device's battery to full capacity each night.

I will keep food and beverages away from my Device since they may cause damage to the device.

I will not disassemble any part of my Device or attempt any repairs.

I will protect my Device by always carrying it in a secure manner to avoid damage.

I will not carry my Device with the screen open.

I will only use my Device in ways that are appropriate for education.

I will not download music or videos for personal entertainment.

I will not place decorations (stickers, markers, writing, etc.) on the Device.

I understand that the Device I am issued is subject to inspection at any time without notice and it remains the property of Caro Community Schools.

I will follow the policies outlined in the 1:1 Device Policy Handbook and the District's

Technology Acceptable Use Policy while at school as well as outside the school day.

I will file a police report in case of theft or damage caused by fire.

I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect, horseplay, or abuse.

I agree to pay the full replacement cost of my Device (or any part of it), power cord/charger, or case in the event that any of these items are lost or intentionally damaged.

I agree to return the Device, power cord/charger in good working condition at the end of each school year.

I understand that the following items represent carelessness (not accidents) and I agree that if they occur, I am responsible for the full amount of the repair

- 1. Two (2) of the same breaks per year (IE: 2 broken screens in one year)
- 2. Placing something between the screen and the keyboard, resulting in damage to the Device when the lid is closed.
- 3. Stepping or sitting on the Device, causing it to break.
