ANY MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY IN THE LAST 5 YEARS PROHIBITS YOU FROM VOLUNTEERING AT CARO COMMUNITY SCHOOLS. ADDITIONALLY, IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THE OFFENSES LISTED BELOW, ANY FOUND UNDER MCL1535a(1) AND MCL1539b(1), OR IN THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION ACT (MCL28.721), YOU ARE EXCLUDED FROM VOLUNTEERING IN CARO SCHOOLS:

- 1. Accosting, enticing or soliciting a child for immoral purposes.
- 2. Involvement in child sexually abusive activity or material.
- A second or subsequent violation of any combination of engaging in obscene or indecent conduct in public, indecent exposure, or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to either offense.
- 4. First, second, third, or fourth degree Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC).
- 5. Assault with intent to commit CSC.
- 6. If the victim is less than 18 years of age, the crime of gross indecency (except for a juvenile disposition or adjudication), kidnapping, sodomy or soliciting another for prostitution.
- 7. Leading, enticing or carrying away a child under 14 years of age.
- 8. Pandering.
- 9. Any other violation of a state law or local ordinance constituting a sexual offense against an individual less than 18 years of age.
- 10. An offense committed by a sexually delinquent person.
- 11. An attempt or conspiracy to commit one of the offenses listed above.
- 12. Felonious assault on a child, child abuse in any degree or an attempt to commit child abuse in any degree.
- 13. Cruelty, torture or indecent exposure involving a child.
