QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. High School Diploma or equivalent
- 2. Experience in school transportation or related field required
- 3. Advance training in diesel and/or gas engine repair preferred
- 4. Obtain and maintain a CDL class B license, with air brakes and passenger endorsements required
- 5. Maintain all licenses, certifications, qualifications as a Michigan School Bus Driver
- 6. Knowledge of our District's streets and associated areas preferred
- 7. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assures adequate maintenance and repair records are maintained for District vehicles and equipment.
- 2. Maintains the ability to diagnose, repair, rebuild, and make necessary adjustments on all vehicle systems.
- 3. Maintains a thorough knowledge and ability to repair components on all systems, including the ability to operate shop equipment.
- 4. Performs trouble shooting and related repairs on District vehicles and equipment.
- 5. Must own and furnish appropriate tools for working on vehicles.
- 6. Operates all vehicles and equipment according to applicable rules, regulations, safety guidelines, and as prescribed by law.
- 7. Must be able to meet deadlines with severe time constraints.
- 8. Maintains the District's garage and equipment in a clean, orderly, and safe condition.
- 9. Assists in the Annual State Police Bus Inspections.
- 10. Reports any hazardous tool, or condition promptly, and makes recommendations for replacement of needed equipment.
- 11. Uses safe practices at all times.
- 12. Keeps an accurate accounting/inventory of all District owned equipment and supplies.
- 13. Must be able to pass all requirements necessary to be a school bus driver; State specified physical exam annually, able to obtain and retain a Commercial Driver's License, class -B (minimum), P endorsement, with no air brake restrictions, and meet Department of Education requirements.
- 14. Any other duties that the Board/Superintendent may deem appropriate or necessary.

OTHER SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- 1. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with staff, students, and the community.
- 2. Ability to function positively under stress and severe time constraints.
- 3. Ability to perform duties with awareness of all District requirements and Board of Education Policies.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- 1. Ability to stand, walk, use hand to finger, handle or feel objects, tools, or controls; and talk or hear.

- 3. Ability to frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.
- 4. Specific vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.
- 5. Ability to hear conversations in quiet and noisy environments.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

- 1. Regularly works near moving mechanical bus and equipment.
- 2. May frequently work with toxic or caustic chemicals such as petroleum products, degreasers, gas fumes, and sprays.
- 3. May work in outside weather conditions.
- 4. Noise level in the work environment is usually loud and occasionally very loud.
